Ap Ma Padçma

In late September we were pleased to welcome a crew of 4 men and 1 woman coming to help us get our long-awaited building project started. Ap Ma Padçma means "the house of the Ap Ma people." While this building will not be big enough to house all the Ap Ma people, we are in hopes that the villages nearest us will be able to join together in community meetings, church services, courses, seminars, revivals and many other public events. The building will be 120 ft. long and 60 ft. wide at its completion. The building is now 60 x 60 with plans to extend it to its full length in 2010. It has taken many years milling timber, carving posts, bringing in sand and gravel from hours away via canoe and in God's time the building has begun. Like the man who builds a watchtower for his vineyard, we are taking this building project a step at a time. As God is providing the funds, we are moving forward. In His time we will continue to pour concrete



fans, an exterior stem wall and seating.

Helpful Household Hints

Using Zucchini... Everyone knows about Chocolate Zucchini Cake, but there are other ways to use zucchini to enrich your foods without your children fleeing to PNG. One of the ways I get my kids to eat their veggies is to grate up a cup of zucchini into the tomato sauce for lasagna. It also helps the lasagna firm up a bit. Chances are your kids will never know it is there. Also if you have left-over 2-3 cups of mashed potatoes, stir in a bit of grated zucchini and pressed garlic, half a cup of sour cream, and one egg & make small cakes, coat with flour and fry in butter or bacon grease.
